Indian Ambassador: Qatari talks for investment in infrastructure in India

(Lusail, 31 March, P9, dated 31 March2021).

A meeting of the joint working group next April.

His Excellency Dr. Deepak Mittal, Ambassador of the Republic of India to Doha, praised the Qatari-Indian relations, which he described as historical since the pearl trade, in addition to the strong ties between the peoples of the two countries. He said that Doha is the number one supplier of LNG to India and it is a reliable partner in energy security. During a press conference yesterday with the local press, Ambassador Mittal noted the importance of the joint work team between the two countries to develop the gas infrastructure, explaining that the next meeting of the working group will be next April. He said that the Qatar Investment Authority's entry into the education sector through the company (Bay Juice) is the most prominent Qatari investment during the past two years. He pointed out that there are Qatari talks to invest in the field of infrastructure in India. The ambassador said that Qatar has become a global center for major sporting events and tournaments, and his country appreciates the great reforms that Qatar has made to improve workers' conditions.

Joint working group

The ambassador explained that the aim of forming a working group on energy is to create a comprehensive partnership between the two countries, not just buying and selling, especially as India moves towards a gas-based economy, with reliance on gas reaching from 5% to 15% by 2030, which opens up promising prospects and opportunities to enhance cooperation with Qatar is in this sector.

He added that the Joint Working Group on Energy held its first meeting in December and we look forward to another meeting in April to develop the cooperation into a comprehensive strategic partnership such as investing in the development of gas infrastructure in India. "We have 17,000 km of pipelines and our goal is to double them to about 32,000 km. Our infrastructure is linked with neighboring countries, which means that there are opportunities for Qatari investment at the level of the region as a whole. We are also seeking to build networks to distribute gas in about 100 cities and we will need stations," he said. To receive gas, it is a promising sector for cooperation and achieves mutual benefits for both parties.

Qatari investments

In the field of investments, we also seek comprehensive cooperation with programs to attract foreign investments in India. Last year, despite the Corona pandemic, investments entered our country worth about \$ 20 billion for large companies such as Google, Microsoft and others, pointing to the importance of introducing Qatars to investment opportunities in India to achieve Mutual benefits.

The Indian ambassador added that Qatar has made important investments during the past two years, including the Qatar Investment Authority's investment in the Bombay Electricity Company, as well as the BYJUS company, which is a large educational platform in India. There are discussions for more investments with the National Fund for Investment in Infrastructure in India.

Regarding trade exchange, the ambassador said that Qatar and India have very strong commercial relations, and the volume of trade exchange reached 11 billion dollars in 2019 and decreased to about 9 billion dollars in 2020 due to Corona, while the two countries' efforts continue to diversify cooperation as liquefied natural gas is an essential part of the volume of mutual trade. .

He added that India highly values Qatar's role as a reliable and reliable partner in energy security, pointing out that his country imports about 15% of its gas needs from the State of Qatar, which is India's first gas supplier.

High-level visits

The Indian ambassador explained that the Qatari-Indian relations are ancient and historical since the pearl trade and the close relations between the two peoples as well as the converging geography that contributed to strengthening the ties and rapprochement between the two countries and their peoples, and these relations are still very strong, as the last five years have witnessed several reciprocal visits at the highest level, most notably the visit of His Excellency Saheb. His Highness Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al Thani, the Emir of the country to India in 2015, and the visit of His Excellency Mr. Narendra Modi, Prime Minister of the Republic of India to Qatar in 2016, in addition to many visits at various levels, stressing the importance of the close relations between the leaderships of the two countries in deepening and advancing joint cooperation in a way that leads in the interest of the two friendly peoples.

He pointed out that one of the fruits of the telephone conversation between the leaders of the two countries last December was their agreement to strengthen relations, discuss ways to enhance them, and form two working groups to enhance cooperation in the investment and energy sectors.

Political consultations

The Indian ambassador emphasized the continuation of political consultations between the two countries to advance cooperation relations in various sectors, pointing to a successful visit by Indian Foreign Minister Dr. Jaishankar to Doha recently and also holding the fourth round of political consultations between the foreign ministries of the two countries last February, pointing out that there will be more. Technical meetings between the governments of the two countries to enhance cooperation in the security, defense, trade, energy and other sectors in the coming period, stressing that they are very positive signs of the prospects for developing joint cooperation, especially as they are sponsored by the leaderships of the two countries.

Ambassador Mittal praised the partnership between the two countries, saying: We are proud of the cooperation of one of the Indian giants - Larsen & Toubro - with local companies to build Al Rayyan Stadium - Ahmed Bin Ali - and therefore India's participation has gone beyond workers and technical experts to companies and the main contractor. He pointed out that there are a number of projects in which Indian companies operate, including road works, electricity distribution stations, and many positive partnerships in infrastructure projects. We certainly look forward to intensifying our partnership in other sectors, such as the jewelry industry, which India excels, as well as direct bilateral business relations between companies from the two countries.

Events Center

Ambassador Mittal noted that Qatar has become a major global center for major international sporting events and tournaments, and the 2022 World Cup is one of them, and there will be the 2030 Asian Games and many international tournaments. He said: I recently met athletes from India who visited Qatar in events such as the tennis tournament and table tennis, and expressed their admiration for the sports facilities on the land of Qatar, as well as the wonderful organization. She also discussed with the Secretary of the Qatar Olympic Committee the possibility of cooperation in many areas related to youth and sports. I am confident that Qatar's 2022 World Cup staging will be very successful. The infrastructure in the sports sector is very great.

Regarding the reforms undertaken by the State of Qatar: The Indian ambassador said that his country appreciates the great and positive reforms that Qatar has recently undertaken in order to improve the conditions of workers, and we welcome them, and our comment on them was very

positive in international forums, the last of which was the meeting of the International Labor Organization last November. In Geneva. With regard to cooperation in the field of education, the ambassador said that the education sector in Qatar is booming strongly, and there are 18 Indian schools and 3 more schools have been approved, and the number of Indian students studying in these schools is about 45,000 students, which is a large number and we thank the Qatari authorities that provide assistance. In providing the educational needs of these students, and there is a tendency to establish an Indian university, which we hope to start studying in September 2021 and will include many disciplines in the fields of science, humanities, and engineering, and we are confident that the opening of this university will push other universities to take similar steps, especially with the great success of educational institutions. As big as Hamad Bin Khalifa University and Qatar Foundation, we may witness the establishment of a College of Medicine modeled after Weill Cornell, and education will remain one of the main pillars of the relationship between the two countries.

Cultural year

The ambassador praised the success of the Qatar-India Year of Culture 2019, praising the great support from the Ministry of Culture and Sports, the Qatar Museums Authority, the Qatar National Library and the Cultural Village (Katara). It will be interspersed with the organization of the 2022 World Cup, and we hope to hold cultural events within the framework of these celebrations, which will confirm the cultural diversity enjoyed by the State of Qatar. Diameter. Events such as these increase the rapprochement between the peoples who live on the land of Qatar.
